

#### **EVACUATION ROUTES:**

Incidents requiring evacuation in Mineral County will use as primary routes of travel: US Highways 95 and 95 A at Schurz and State Highways 359 and 361. These identified routes have been selected due to traffic volume capacity. Other routes can be utilized based on the situation.

**Hawthorne:** US Highway 95 and State Highway 359 are the major transportation routes through

Hawthorne.

Luning: US Highway 95 is the major transportation route and State Highway 361 also leads from US

Highway 95 at the North end of Luning.

*Marietta:* Marietta has only one graded dirt road in and out of the community.

*Mina*: US Highway 95 is the main transportation route through Mina.

*Schurz:* US Highway 95 and US Highway 95 Alternate are the main transportation routes in and out

of Schurz.

*Walker Lake:* US Highway 95 is the main transportation route within Walker Lake.
